FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

What is the purpose of the Directors Summit?

Following Directors School 2022, many attendees expressed an interest in connecting throughout the year. After more discussion, an idea was suggested that Directors School graduates host a mid-year gathering, now called the Directors Summit. This year will be hosted by Nova Parks in Fairfax, VA.

When is the Summit occurring?

Monday, March 4 and Tuesday, March 5, 2024. It is recommended that travel days occur on Saturday, March 2 and Wednesday, March 6 to participate in tours, educational workshops, and connection/network building activities.

What is the Virtual Meet and Greet?

Our workshop facilitator, Farrell Burrell from 110% will be hosting a meet and greet for attendees to get familiar with one another and the workshop goals, prior to the event. The [virtual meet up](#) will occur on February 8, 8:00 am PST.

What can I expect from the Summit?

The primary goal of the Directors Summit is connection building. Current Directors School attendees as well as past graduates will engage in both small and large group discussions about current issues facing parks and recreation. Questions will also be posed throughout the workshop to invited one-on-one discussion and to build future virtual forum topics.

Is there a cost to attend the Summit?

Thanks to our generous sponsors, the Summit is available for the low cost of \$100 per attendee. Most meals will be included. Travel not provided during the program is the attendees responsibility. [Registration is open now.](#)

Is the Summit CEU eligible?

At this time, the Summit is not CEU eligible as the focus is on connecting with other Parks and Recreation leaders from across the country; however, we are working to see if a portion of the workshop may be eligible.

What is the weather like in Virginia?

Weather may still be cold this time of year, though spring will be on the horizon. We encourage you to pack warmer clothing as we will be outside for many social events and workshop activities.

Is there a host hotel?

There are two options for accommodations; either sharable cabins with shared open area, kitchen, bathroom on the river in NOVA Park (approximately \$85 nt/person) or there are hotel accommodations close by.

If you would like to stay in the cabins, you will need to select your cabin mates, or they will be assigned at random.
